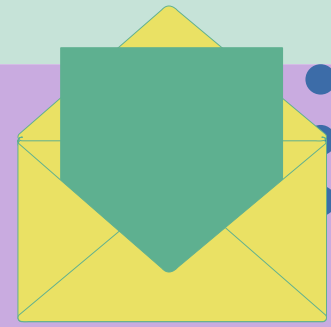

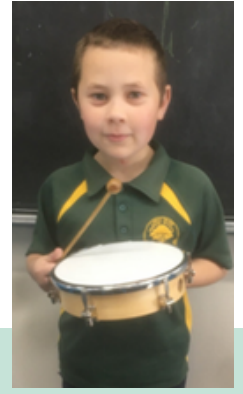
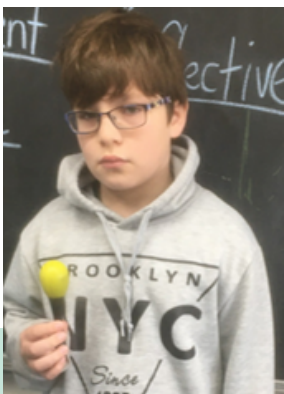




MUSIC IN ME PROGRAM

Week 5 is Book Week and we will be having the Scholastic Book Fair and a Book Week Parade.

BookFair

On Monday 18th students will be taken through the Book Fair by their classroom teacher or SSO to create their "Wish List". If you wish to purchase books from the "Wish List", you can do so by either:

1. Sending money in with your child and they can purchase the books
OR

2. Parents can come in at the following times to purchase:

From 8:30am on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday

After school from 3pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Friday

or between 9.30am – 11:00am Friday (after the Book Parade)

The Book Fair will be housed in the Library.

Books can be purchased by EFTPOS, cash, OSKO transfer, or direct deposit to the school bank account BSB: 105-055 A/C number: 229284940. Clearly label payment with the family name and email remittance to dl.0223.info@schools.sa.edu.au (If you choose direct deposit, books will need to remain at school until the money appears in the school bank account.)

Competitions:

This year we will be running two competitions! A colouring in competition – 3 winners will receive a \$10 voucher to put towards a book from the book fair. We will also have a best dressed competition – 3 winners will be picked from the parade on Friday morning and they will receive a \$10 voucher to put towards a book from the book fair. Good luck everyone!

This year's theme is "Book an Adventure" and we will hold our parade on Friday 22nd of August at 9.00am on the Blue Court. Students are encouraged to dress up as their favourite character & join in the parade on Friday morning. Parents and Grandparents are welcome to attend. We then invite all parents and grandparents to stay for morning tea/a look at the books in the Library after the Assembly and parade.
